AutoCAD vs. other CAD programs AutoCAD is the most widely used CAD program, with more than 25 million licenses sold. Other CAD programs are available as desktop, mobile, and web apps. AutoCAD has a variety of features designed to simplify the design process and create efficient drawings, including commands for creating floor plans, section cuts, and three-dimensional drawings, as well as commands to specify dimensions, plans, text, and graphics. AutoCAD also features automation tools that can help improve productivity and simplify repetitive tasks, like drawing views of parts. In addition, AutoCAD has an extensive feature set for solid modeling and 2D drafting, including 2D and 3D modeling, design tools, drafting methods, and integrated DWG file support. Another advantage of AutoCAD is that it runs on a wide variety of computer operating systems, from Windows to Linux and Mac OS. In addition, there are AutoCAD LT versions available that allow drawing and drafting in 2D for free and require a subscription for more advanced 3D modeling. What hardware do I need? A PC with a 32-bit operating system and a compatible video card, or a laptop or desktop running the AutoCAD LT version, which is available as a free download. A mouse, and a tablet, trackball, or other pointing device, such as the Immediate Graphite pen A keyboard A printer The application requires a 2GHz or faster CPU, but the program will run slower on a slower computer. You can also run AutoCAD as a stand-alone application or as part of an integrated suite such as AutoCAD LT. The AutoCAD Extensibility Architecture, allows AutoCAD to exchange information with other applications that are used in conjunction with AutoCAD.
