The program does not create a disk image. It simply makes a copy of the existing content. You can adjust the files and then restore the hard disk. HDCopy creates a folder with an image name that you can choose. You can rename it or keep it as it is. It is not really important for you that the name of the folder is the date you started the copying. It has no relation to the date of the backup. You can choose a different name. The program will always create a copy of your entire hard disk no matter which disk drive you select. For example, if you have a USB hard disk drive and want to create an image of your hard disk on your regular computer hard disk you can do it from the same USB. HDCopy will automatically create two copies. The copy will not contain any of your personal information as the operating system and your applications. It will have only the files that you choose. You can only back up those that you want to protect. That is why it is so important to make a backup prior to making changes to the hard disk or an USB. As you have all the information about the copied files it will be very easy for you to restore the files whenever you need it. As HDCopy is not a program for creating an ISO disk image you cannot use it with Windows Vista. It works only with Windows 2000/XP. You can only use your backup on the same partition and it will only work on a hard disk drive that is detected by Windows. It works with directories only. So you have to make a backup of the directory or choose the files you want to save instead of the whole hard disk. HDCopy is a free and open source software utility for creating a mirror image of a hard disk or partition on any storage device. You can copy or move files or folders between partitions, from one hard disk to another, or from one storage device to another. It is very similar to the Windows DD copy tool but it runs under Linux. This is the only source of income for the developers.**** You can have a look at the following screenshot: This is how you start HDCopy: You will be asked to choose the source drive and the destination folder. You can choose your target folder on another drive using the "Source Path" tab. You can chose to copy only the files or also the folder structure. In our test HDCopy copied the files and all the sub-folders. When you start the copy process you will be asked to choose the destination folder on the target drive. You can use it for your new backup, or simply change the destination folder. When the copy process is started you will be asked to choose the format of the file. In our test we chose to create a NTFS partition. If you want to create a FAT partition you have to set the "Format" option to FAT32 or FAT16. At the end you will be asked if you want to save the configuration. Otherwise you will be offered to restore the default configuration. The following are the options we can select: Performance, which determines the speed of the copy process Creation of a chain linked image, which copies all the files at once without intermediary copies In the screenshot we can see a new folder containing the created image.
