Until the late 1990s, AutoCAD was designed for 2D drafting. This was due to limitations of the internal graphics drivers and screen-buffer architecture, so it was not possible to display 3D drawings in AutoCAD. In the early 2000s, Autodesk introduced a 2D and 3D drawing mode called DWF (Dynamic Web Format). DWF is a proprietary file format based on the XML (extensible markup language) format, and is used as a container format to store 3D drawing models, geometries, materials, layers, named views and other objects that can be placed, moved, rotated and scaled. DWF documents are read by some 3D CAD viewers and editors, and can be exported in other CAD formats, such as DXF. In the later part of the 2000s, Autodesk announced the release of the DWG native format, a variant of the previous DWF format, that was developed to overcome the disadvantages of DWF. The native format is designed to store 2D and 3D geometry natively, instead of storing drawings as floating-point numbers, which results in loss of precision, small inaccuracies and other problems. DWG documents are read by some CAD viewers and editors, and can be exported in other CAD formats, such as DXF. Other improvements made in later versions of AutoCAD include new tools and features such as AutoCAD 360°, which allows users to create and view 3D drawings, 2D drawing annotations and annotations (annotations that appear on the drawings when the drawing is printed), 2D and 3D sheet metal tools, B-Rep modeling, a variable block size that allows users to create large models without the need for a powerful computer, the ability to place and edit footprints, and a graphical interface that allows users to drag and drop and move objects on drawings.
